Dear People of God,

Last week I briefly discussed early Irish cathedrals. Because the Church was made illegal by the English, there were no great Irish Catholic cathedrals until fairly late into the nineteenth century. Most were relatively small because the Catholic population represented the bulk of those immigrating to other lands following the potato famine (many became the heritage families of Immaculate Conception, St. Patrick and Good Shepherd). An example of this is the cathedral at Cloyne, a village not far from Midleton which you may know as the home of Jameson's distillery. The cathedral was founded around 580 by St. Coleman and eventually taken over by the Church of Ireland. The Catholic cathedral, now high atop the city of Cobh (pronounced Cove), is some ten miles from Cloyne but the diocese is still that of Cloyne and is considered the seat of the Bishop of Cork City. The cathedral was built around the same time as Immaculate Conception, St. Anne and St. Patrick. Its steeple cross would have been the last vestige of Europe seen by anyone on the fantail of *Titanic* who was looking back toward the embarkation point. Cobh was selected because it had become a major port city and the cathedral honors St. Coleman.



Many people who visit Ireland want to see St. Patrick Cathedral in Dublin which they believe to be the Catholic cathedral. It isn't. Built during the Catholic ascendancy in the 12th Century and dedicated to Mary, the Mother of God and St. Patrick in 1191, it was taken over by the Anglicans and eventually turned over to the Church of Ireland. Like Washington National Cathedral, it is considered the nation's cathedral so has no bishop (he presides at nearby Christ Church cathedral) and is administered by a board which includes prelates of all the major Churches in Ireland, including the Catholic archbishop of Dublin. Prior to the creation of the Republic, many Catholics demanded its return but today it serves as a sacred space for all Irish, those in Ireland and those of us here in Ohio.

As of now there is no Catholic cathedral in Dublin. St. Mary's, a few blocks from the General Post Office (where the 1916 Easter Rising was headquartered), serves as a pro-cathedral. In 2023 the archbishop petitioned Rome to make St.

Mary's a basilica and create a cathedral at St. Andrew near Trinity College. Both are magnificent worship spaces built in the latter part of the nineteenth century.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

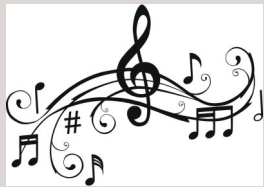

The Diocese of Toledo is in compliance with the articles of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People* of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB).

Every year, the Diocese dutifully submits the necessary documentation required by the USCCB for a diocese to be in compliance.

Every three years an on-site audit is conducted, when not only all necessary documentation is dutifully submitted, but in addition, Pastoral Center, parish and diocesan school employees are interviewed concerning practices and protocols related to creating and maintaining a safe environment for our children and youth.

The last 3-year audit was conducted in October of 2021. The next on-site audit will be conducted in September of 2024.

The Diocese of Toledo remains committed to ensuring the protection of children and providing a safe environment for all young people. If you have any knowledge of abuse that has been committed by a cleric or by any personnel of the Catholic Church, you are urged to report the abuse to your local police department, Children Services, and the Diocesan Victim Assistance Coordinator at (419) 214-4880; or by mail at 1933 Spielbusch Avenue; Toledo, Ohio 43604.

Signs of Postural Orthostatic Tachycardia Syndrome. Common signs of POTS. POTS symptoms vary which makes it hard to diagnose. People may have some or many of these symptoms: racing heart and lightheadedness when going from lying down to standing, reddish-purple color in feet or legs, Heart palpitations or feeling your heart pounding or racing., shortness of breath, weakness and fatigue, severe headache, digestion -related problems such as nausea, constipation or vomiting; poor concentration or confusions, trouble sleeping, blurred vision, trouble exercising.
