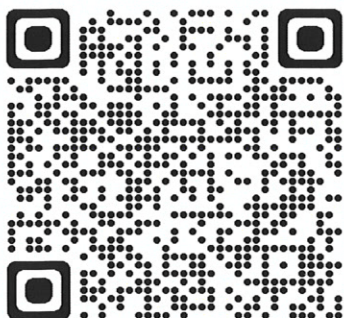

“The Angel Tree 2024”

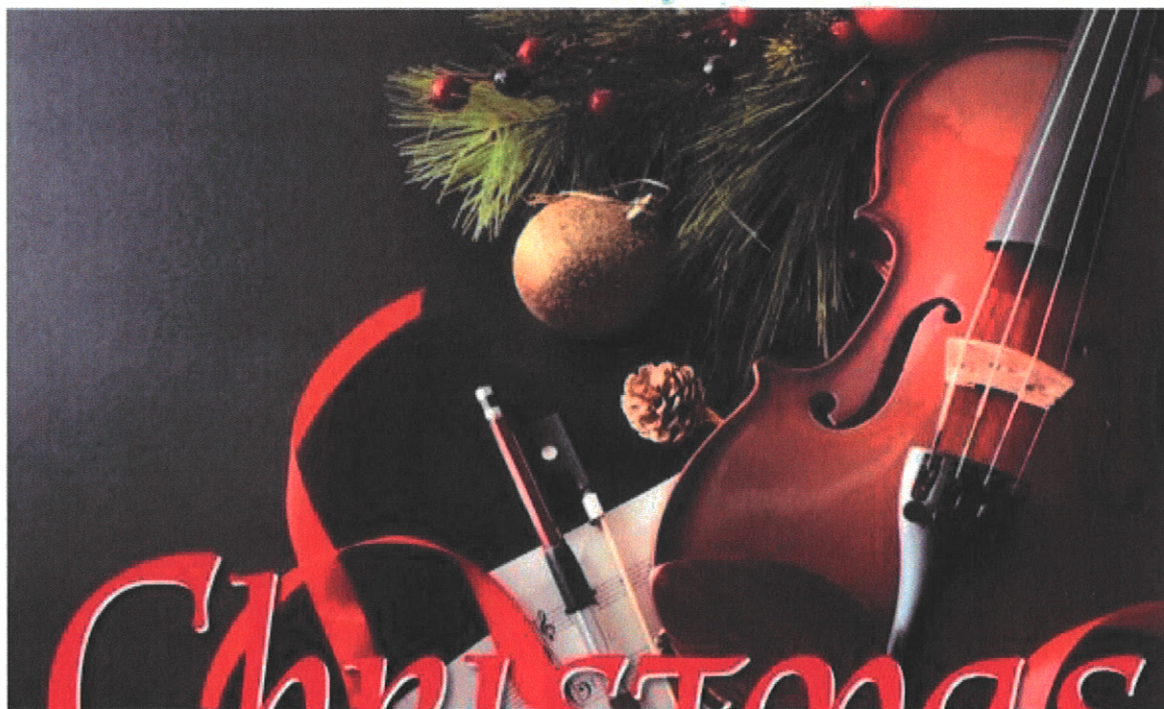

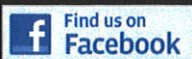

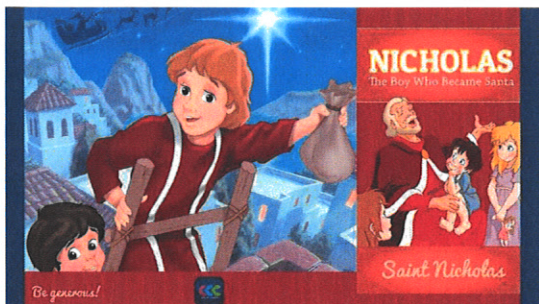
30 Minutes BC
