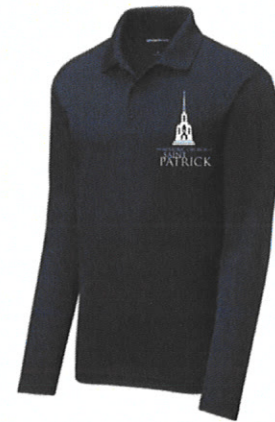
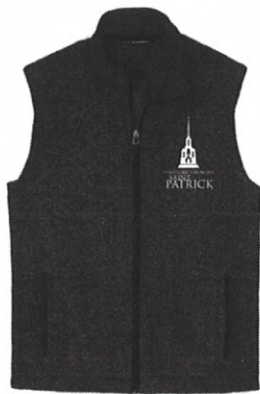

Once it is closed, we will collect, print, and sort all of the orders within 15 business days. All orders will be picked up by the Historic Church of St. Patrick and distributed.

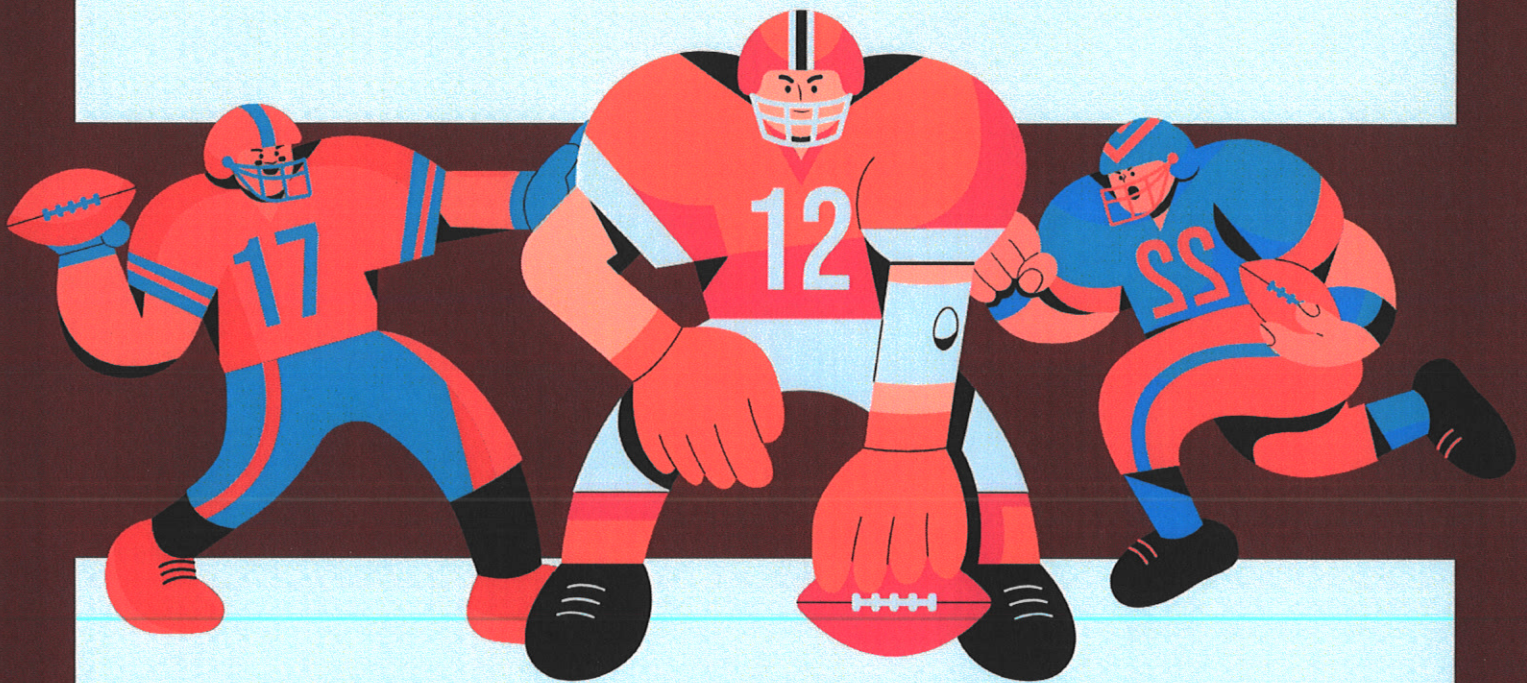

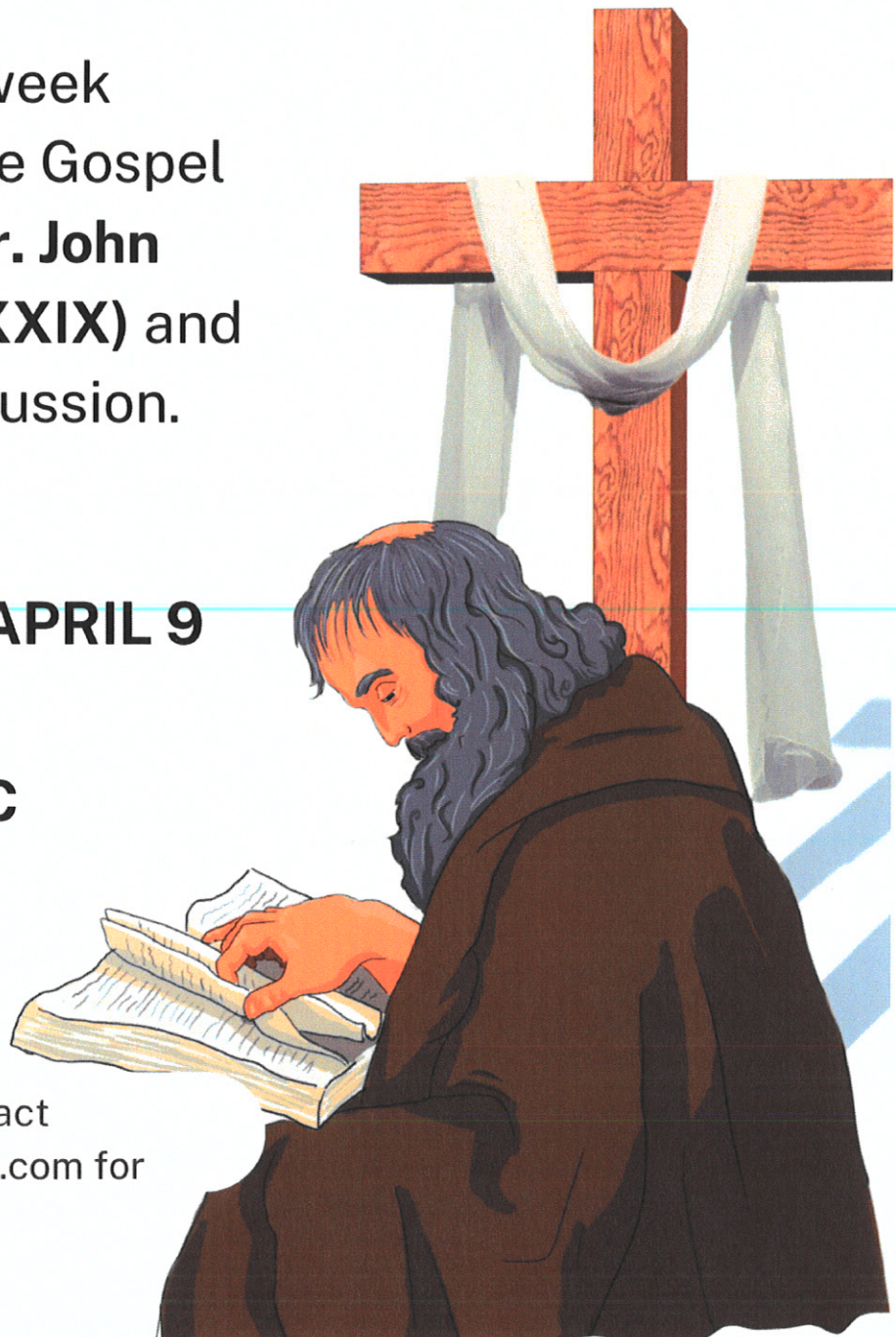

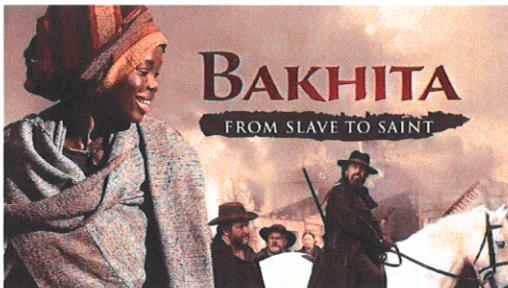
St. Josephine Bakhita: A Story of God's Rescue
