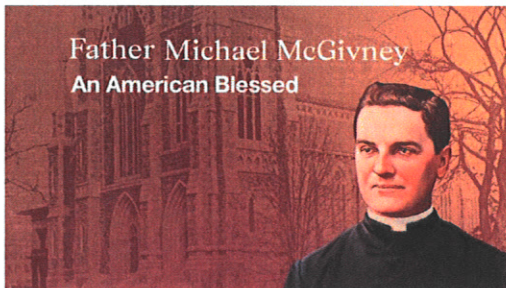
The dates are for an hour.

Mass is at 5:30 p.m. For an extra lift attend this also.

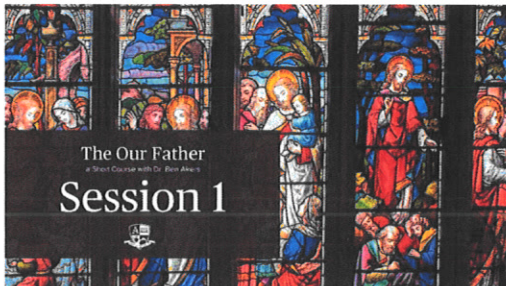

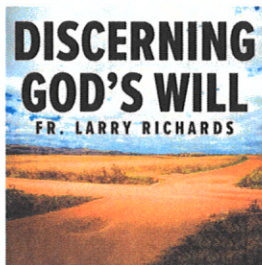
An American Blessed
