-Each month from March-July students will be selling 50/50 tickets after Mass. \$2 each or 3/\$5

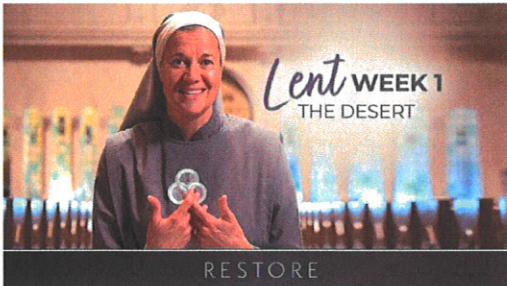
-Tickets will be sold the first 2 weeks of each month and the winner will be announced on the third week.

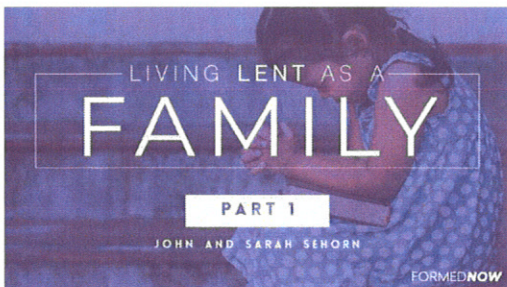
Week One | Restore
