Emphasizes our mortality and our need for ongoing repentance.

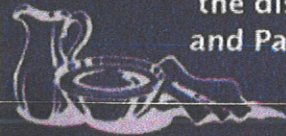
PALM SUNDAY

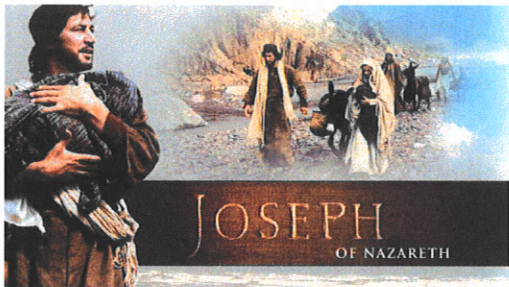

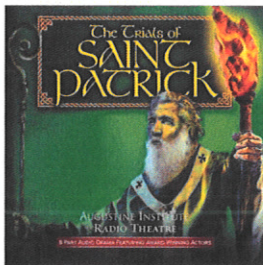

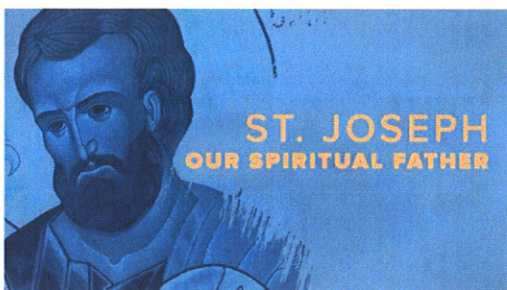
Joseph of Nazareth
