





Blessing Of Easter Food

In some European countries the blessing of Easter foods is an important tradition. This blessing is still found in the updated Roman Ritual, and is a wonderful practice. Many parishes still participate in this custom of the blessing of the Easter food or baskets. The blessing is done on Holy Saturday and shared on Easter Sunday morning with family and friends. It is said that the blessed food may promote health of body, and salvation of the soul for those who partake of it. There is a specific blessing for each type of food included in the basket. Traditionally, they include sausage, bread, cheese, eggs, lamb (cake or butter), pastry, horseradish, wine, and salt. 


