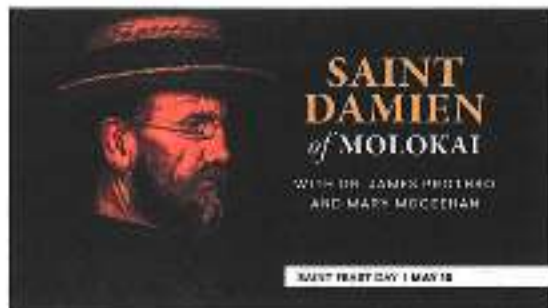

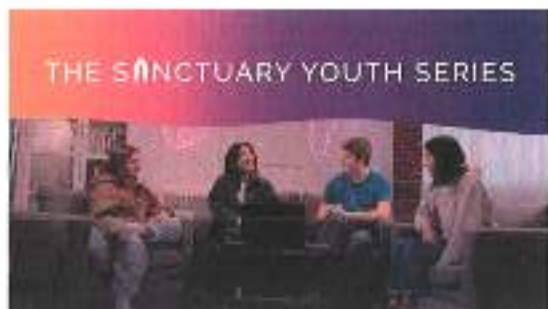

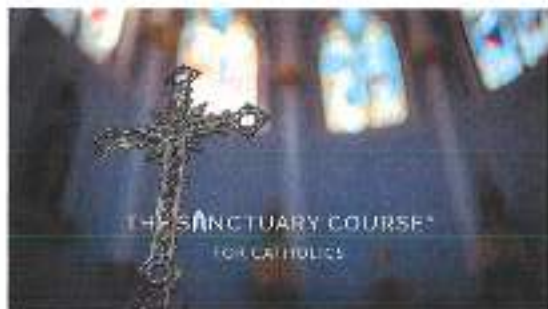
## St. Damien of Molokai | Catholic Saints

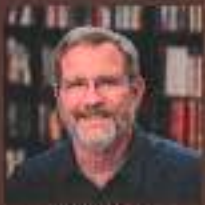
