Dear People of God,

The secular world is one in which we function on a daily basis. While we don't use the term *synodality*, we do understand the idea behind it: everybody in a democracy has his or her say and can take part, within limits. Men and women, young and old, have a role to play in our system of government. Francis thought that would be a great way for the Church to function when and where it can do so.

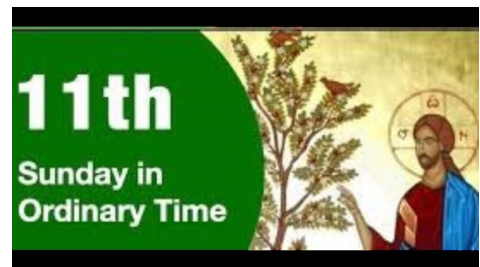
In addition to synodality, another hot topic in the Church today is something called the *Sedevacantism Movement*. In essence there are people who insist that the Chair of St. Peter is currently vacant (*sede vacante* means *empty chair*), i.e. we don't really have a pope. They base this on suppositions about a papal conclave years ago (conveniently eliminating any real witness to the "facts" who could verify their claims.) At this conclave, some sort of coercion was allegedly used to replace a legitimately elected pope with someone else who then went out and undertook to bring the Church into the modern era.

Why a pope in the first place? This stems from the famous scriptural word of Jesus himself: "You are Peter and on this rock I will build my Church," and the three-times-repeated command to Peter at the end of the Gospel of John "to feed my sheep." It makes sense that the Church, the Body of Christ, needs a central and final authority who is entrusted with the authority of the Holy Spirit to be the rock on which the entire Church is founded. We recently celebrated the Ascension when Jesus returned to the Father and commanded his disciples to "go and teach all nations..." This directive needed somebody to be the one who organizes and stabilizes how that works. From the very beginning, there was a clear understanding that we needed a First Among Equals (the pope) and the College of Apostles (Bishops). How this functioned from the first days is recorded in a collection called Denzinger which has the official acts of the major councils and gatherings of the Church.

However, there have always been those who believe they are smarter than Jesus who insist they know more about how the Church should function than does the Pope or the two and half thousand bishops gathered in a council. Most recently this has led to those who deny the effectiveness of the Second Vatican Council which is why Pope Leo has been using his Wednesday general audiences to examine the documents promulgated by the Council, documents the Sedevacantism don't like. Many of the arguments put forward by these groups were discussed at length during the preparatory stages of the Council and can be found for study and reflection. A bit of research on the internet will lead to them, but when several thousand bishops conclude that a document accurately expresses the Will of the Holy Spirit, opposing it is not a good idea and can be likened to Adam and Eve being told by God "don't do that" but being smarter than God, they did it anyway; look what happened after that!

There is a place in the Church for discussion and debate but there is that famous desk with the placard which states: the buck stops here.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

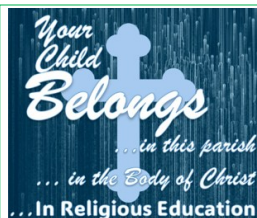
