Dear People of God,

I was recently given a copy of the 1922 report of the annual campaign to support diocesan programs, what we today call the ACA. It lists the donations by parish and by donor. St. Patrick gave enough to buy two and a half new cars at 1922 prices and Immaculate Conception donated enough for two new cars. Not bad, especially for Immaculate Conception which was paying off the huge debts incurred from rebuilding after a disastrous fire two years earlier.

I thought I'd do some comparing, so here's a quote from Kelly Blue Book: In July, 2025, the new-vehicle ATP was \$48,841, down 0.1% from the revised lower June ATP of \$48,900. Presuming we were as generous as in 1922, the donation for diocesan ministries from St. Patrick would be 122,102.50 and from Immaculate Conception 97,682. However, when we look at how well the ACA is doing in our parishes, we aren't close to those numbers. There are substantial reasons for giving less, from an aging population on fixed incomes to a lot of expenses for things that weren't even invented in 1922. Nevertheless, while we all gripe about how expensive things have gotten, few of us have cancelled our internet subscription or our streaming services or curtailed the use of our cell phones, i-pads and what-not. I would guess that for many of us – not everyone given that fixed incomes tend to be among the matured generation - what we do spend on things like that gravely affects what we have left for God and His Church (to say nothing about gas and groceries).

I learned many years ago from our late auxiliary bishop Albert Ottenweller that, as St. Paul writes, "God loves a generous giver;" what we sacrificially hand over to God's work will return to us many times over. That doesn't mean we'll all win the lottery and retire to a private island in the South Pacific, but it does mean if we truly trust God, we will never lack for what we genuinely need. I put that to the test in one of my previous assignments, challenging parishioners to undertake a gift of their first fruits: those who made a contract to do so ended up the fiscal year ahead of their neighbors.

While our gifts to the Annual Catholic Appeal may not reach the stellar heights of the price of a couple of cars, we ought to aim a bit higher than a new spare tire. Everyone registered in the parish should have received a couple of mailings outlining all that the ACA seeks to accomplish. Get them out, review them and pray over what you can do so that our diocese can continue to "teach all nations." Thanks to those who have made a gift or pledge to support the broader Church beyond parish boundaries.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

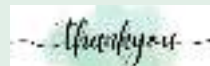
