Dear People of God,

After the long period of Lent and Easter, we are now back to Ordinary Time which is not ordinary in the usual sense of the word. Because it coincides with the wonderful weather of summer and our vacation time, we may well miss the meaning of the season. This is the time when all the sacrifices of Lent and the joy of Easter should lead us to live out the gifts of grace and love poured into each of us through Jesus' life, death and resurrection. The Bishops of the United States pointed out that each of us has been commanded by God to love God, our neighbors and ourselves. They recommend that each parish undertake this year 250 hours of the Works of Mercy. In case you've forgotten them, they include feeding the hungry, giving clothing to the needy, sheltering the homeless, visiting the imprisoned, aiding the sick and comforting the dying.

There are many ways of accomplishing this; most of us default to either the ACA or the Sunday collection which fund programs to meet those needs. However, there are numerous opportunities in the parish and beyond to volunteer to do the actual work involved in those famous Works. The food pantry can always use a few strong arms to shelve donations and even a quick visit to the pantry on Monday, Wednesday or Friday from noon till 2 would let you know what items are in greatest need at any given time.

Our Sunday morning soup kitchen can also use help; if you stop by, ask Elaine what she might have in mind for a healthy dinner down the road; she'll no doubt have many ideas for special donations. One of the oldest continually operating soup kitchens in Toledo provides breakfast at St. Martin de Porres: a quick call there would let you know what sort of casserole dish you might prepare for sharing with the needy. There are other food pantries in our deanery at just about every parish in addition to clothing drives now and again.

Visiting the sick, especially to bring the comfort of the Eucharist, is another great idea, whether here, at one of the regional hospitals or at another parish that is short of visitors. Even within our own church, there is always a great need for ministers to greet people as they come into the church, serve as lectors, ushers and Eucharistic Ministers, work with the Evangelization team at the Irish Store, provide hospitality after Mass or take up some other volunteer efforts around the parish. None of these takes all that much time but together assists the parish in meeting its responsibility to provide for the needs of others while giving each of us a way to make that happen. Opportunities exist; seek what fits your talents.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

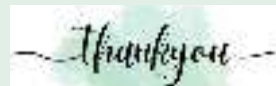
