

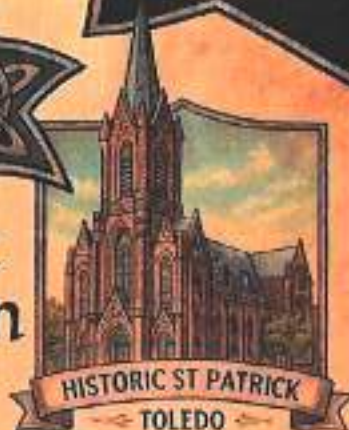

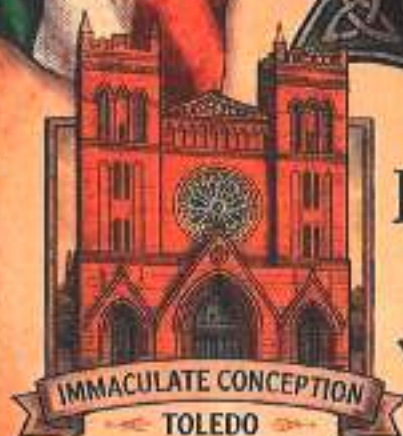

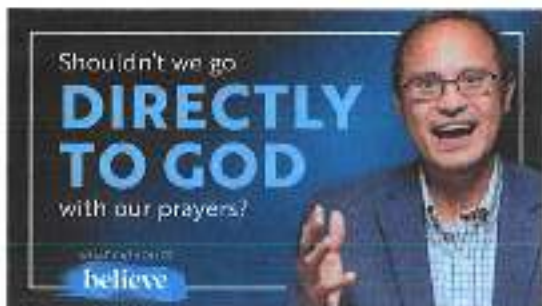
St. Kateri Tekakwitha | God's Princesses
