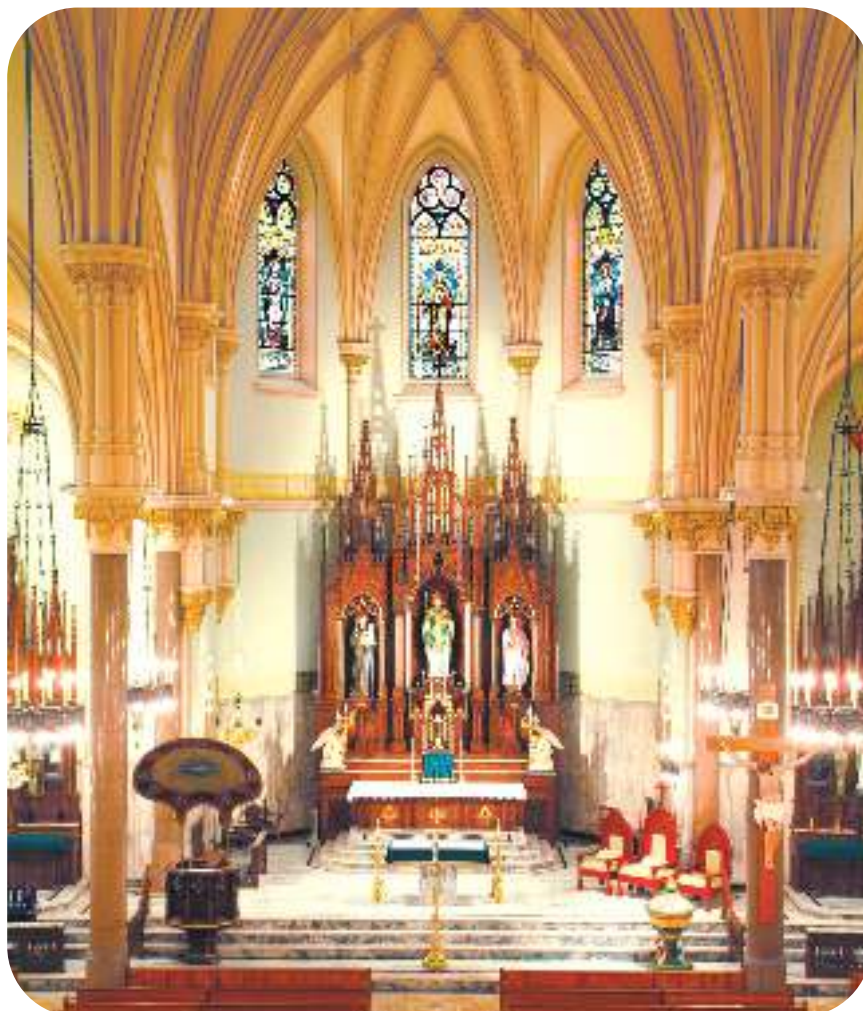

Dear People of God,

This past June the priests of the diocese gathered for Convocation, an opportunity for discovering new and exciting things which will be occurring here in the diocese. Our thematic program focused on a future direction for all of us to pursue in creating an environment which fosters greater knowledge of and desire for vocations. Being a mind reader, I know most of you reading this will have leapt to the conclusion that I'm talking about more priests. Although that's part of it, for those of my generation vocation meant a way of life lived for the greater glory of God, relating to the world while seeking holiness in whatever career path God opened up for us. We relate to the world, according to the Baltimore Catechism, in one of three ways: as single people whether the young ones before marriage where all of us got our start on the road to holiness or perhaps later in life when a beloved spouse heads off the kingdom before we do. Being single as a vocation implies putting God first so we behave in ways that lead to a spiritual sense of ourselves.

The second area of vocations is marriage, a relationship which most of us will wend our way into. Again, it demands behaviors which assist our spouse attaining heaven and seeking holiness to make that happen. The third vocation is to relate to the world from a totally spiritual union with God. There are two ways to do that: the one you've been thinking of as a priest or deacon, and the other as consecrated religious which includes sisters, brothers, nuns, monks and a few other very specialized states of life. Again, there are expected behaviors which lead to personal holiness and a way of relating to the world around us.

The diocese is partnering with a national movement, *Vocations Ministry* which has a fifteen year history of developing simple, easy to apply techniques to make vocations a way of life rather than an occasional subject for a letter in the bulletin! Because I was certainly excited by what the presenter had to say, I ask that you watch for upcoming details. I know that this year's Diocesan Pastoral Conference on September 24 will focus on this same area and bring back the same dynamic presenter so consider spending the day to learn more. We'll also be looking for a few new faces to head up a vocations committee in the parish to implement some of the ideas developed by Vocations Ministries which have shown good results in parishes like ours. Since I know we live in a culture which doesn't volunteer, please be ready to say "yes" when invited to become part of this committee. There will be a session for these people on Saturday, September 26. It sounds exciting and let's be honest: all of us already have a vocation so let's work together to make those vocations better for singles, married people and those called by God to a life as consecrated religious or in Holy Orders.

The Celebration of Sacraments

Infant Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is regularly celebrated on Sunday during or after the Eucharistic Liturgy. Registered parishioners are asked to arrange for the Baptismal Preparation Class and the Liturgical Celebration by calling the Parish Office.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults: RCIA is the process of growing in your faith and love of God. Weekly gatherings take place from September until Easter. If you are interested in learning about Catholicism and joining us please call Deacon Tom at the rectory.

Penance: The Sacrament of Penance is celebrated at 3:30 p.m. on Saturday at IC, 9:30 a.m. at HSP and 10:30 a.m. IC every Sunday or by appointment.

Matrimony: Anyone planning to be married must contact the parish at least six months in advance. The exact date and time of your wedding should not be determined until after consultation with a priest or deacon. If either party has previously been civilly or religiously married, the Presider is not permitted to set a date for the wedding without resolving the previous marriage.

Pastoral Care of the Sick: When a parishioner is admitted to the hospital, nursing home, or confined to home because of age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office. Parishioners are ready to visit and to bring Holy Communion. When one is seriously ill, the healing Presence of the Lord should be requested in the Sacrament of the Sick.

Christ Child Society of Toledo is looking for women to join its organization. Christ Child is dedicated to serving the needs of underserved children and youth—for the love of the Christ Child.

Christ Child is an all-volunteer organization with more than 200 local members who donate over 15,000 hours annually. Christ Child's largest program is **Clothe-a-Child** where 2,000 new coats, hats, gloves, and books are purchased each year and then distributed to children from birth through 8th grade. Through the Layette Program, more than 1,600 layette/newborn care packages are distributed to underserved new moms in the fall and spring.

Christ Child volunteers tutor and offer library assistance at Rosary Cathedral, Gesu, Queen of Apostles School, and Hope Learning Academy. Volunteers also teach classes for new and expectant parents at several local service agencies and assist with other programs including Angle Layettes and Theatre Vision.

Health News for July 12, 2026

Summer Storm Safety: During a storm

Get out and away from pools and bodies of water. Do not shelter by or under tall objects. Lightning tends to strike high places.

If you're driving during a storm, pull over safely and stay in your vehicle with your seatbelt on. Avoid touching metal surfaces. Do not park under trees or power lines.

Stay away from objects that conduct electricity, like wires and fences.

Never lie flat on the ground.

Avoid taking a shower or using devices that are plugged in.

Stay indoors, ideally in an interior room without windows.

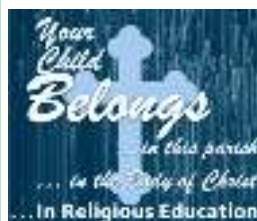
