The Basics

- **Who?** Lay parish employees & volunteers (religious sisters & brothers are welcome). Maximum annual cohort of 24 participants.
- **What?** Formation including all four dimensions: human, spiritual, intellectual & pastoral, focused on equipping for the concrete realities of parish ministry.
- **When?** Monthly formation gatherings and small groups over a two year period. A new cohort will start every year.
- **Where?** Hybrid in person and virtual formats.
- **Why?** Equip the laity for the work of the New Evangelization in their parishes and to more significantly support their pastors.
- **Cost?** \$200 - includes all formation, meals and material. Total Value = \$1,400. This formation program is made possible by the Living Christ Capital Campaign.

Individualized Growth Plan

Walk with a regional small group that meets monthly for prayer, sharing, accountability, and theological reflection.

Journey with a member of our diocesan team that will help guide you through your formation process.

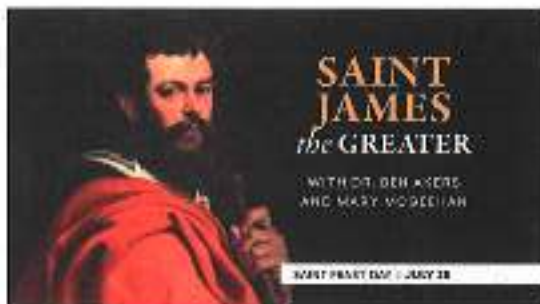

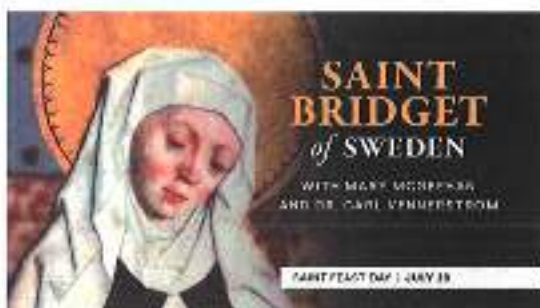
