Then join us after 10 a.m. Mass on **Sunday, September 27**, as we walk through the Mass to explain and see the roles of each liturgical ministry. Msgr. Chris will guide us, and experienced ministry volunteers will fill the roles on the altar.

The training will be livestreamed on Facebook and YouTube, and will be available for future trainings on **The Historic Church of Saint Patrick** YouTube home page.

Those attending can ask questions or get clarification on the practices of each ministry that happen during Mass. Learn the appropriate reverent postures on the altar, and the purpose of behaviors that are part of the Mass. 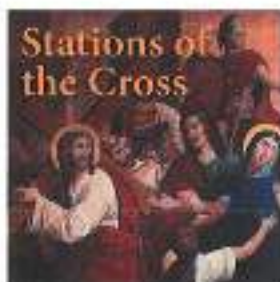
